English Curriculum

This term, we will be linking a lot of our writing to our Geography unit, earthquakes and volcanoes! We will start the term by writing newspaper articles about real earthquakes and volcanoes that have occurred around the world, and then we will be writing our own adventure stories imagining that we are escaping from Pompeii!

Maths Curriculum

This term, we will be focusing on telling the time, building on our geometry skills, and using statistics and data to solve problems. We will also be practicing and testing times tables regularly ready for the multiplication check at the start of this term. All pupils have log-ins for Times Table Rockstars to practice our times table skills and we will be using this regularly in school. This is a great way to practice at home too!

Topic

We are focusing on History in our Topic lessons and will be learning about crime and punishment! In this unit we will be learning about how crimes and punishments have changed throughout history and how attitudes towards crimes have progressed.





Science

In Science this term, we will be learning about habitats and how we can protect our environment. We will be thinking about how our local environment has changed, considering aspects of our school grounds that have changed and have a class debate about a hypothetical scenario that would bring about environmental change.

The Wider Curriculum

Art - our focus this term is to investigate how the environment affects how we feel about a place and how art can be used to improve a place. We will be collecting visual information and exploring ideas for a site specific sculpture before creating our own sculptures.

PSHE - our PSHE focus this term is 'growing up and changing'. We will be learning about the way we grow and change throughout the human lifecycle and will learn about the importance of physical hygiene and strategies for managing this. We have a visit from the school nurse to discuss growing up and puberty.

Computing - Mr Bisiker will deliver ICT lessons where we will design, write and debug programs that accomplish specific goals, including controlling or simulating physical systems; solve problems by decomposing them into smaller parts.
