Welcome back! We hope you enjoyed a well-deserved break. Here is an outline of what your child will be learning about this upcoming term.

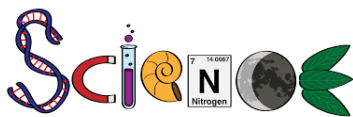

Topic

We will be learning all about ‘Our Local Heroes’. This topic focuses on local significant figures alive today and from the past. Pupils will be using photos and historical artefacts to answer questions and secure their understanding.

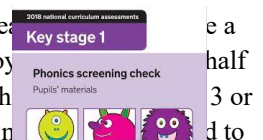
Math’s

In Year 2, pupils will be focusing on time. They will learn to tell the time to o’clock, half past, quarter past and to the hour. Pupils will then progress on to learning all about positional language and statistic’s capacity and temperature, using tools to measure and compare in millilitres, litres and degree Celsius. Year 2 pupils can access Times Table Rock Stars games from home to further embed multiplication facts in a fun, interactive way!

In all Maths lessons, there will be a strong focus on problem solving and giving children the opportunity to explain how they have found their answers.

Reading

Thank you for your continued efforts in supporting your child’s reading. There has been a huge increase in the frequency of reading at home and pupils enjoy term rewards for their efforts. We recommend that pupils read at home 3 or more times a week. Pupils would read at home 4 times a week or more to take part in an exciting treasure hunt at the end of the week!
